This action by the CHP amends a route map for the transportation of explosives by commercial vehicles on highways to correct an error on a route map by removing 21.5 miles and adding 29.0 miles of currently designated routes in the Clear Lake area. It also changes "Clear Lake Oaks" to "Clearlake Oaks" for consistency with the spelling of the town name.

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. This regulatory action becomes effective on 7/22/2021 pursuant to section 31616 of the Vehicle Code.

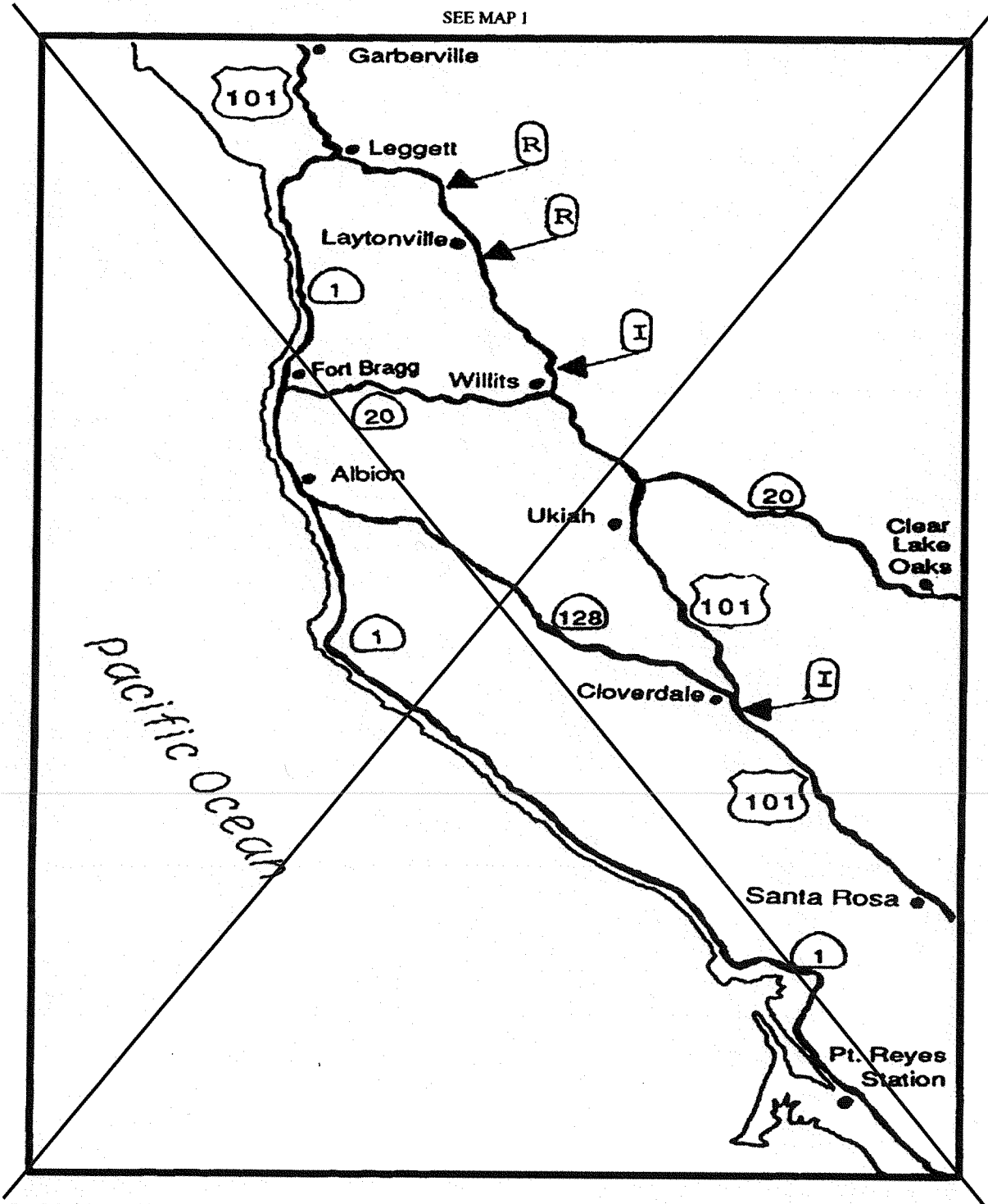

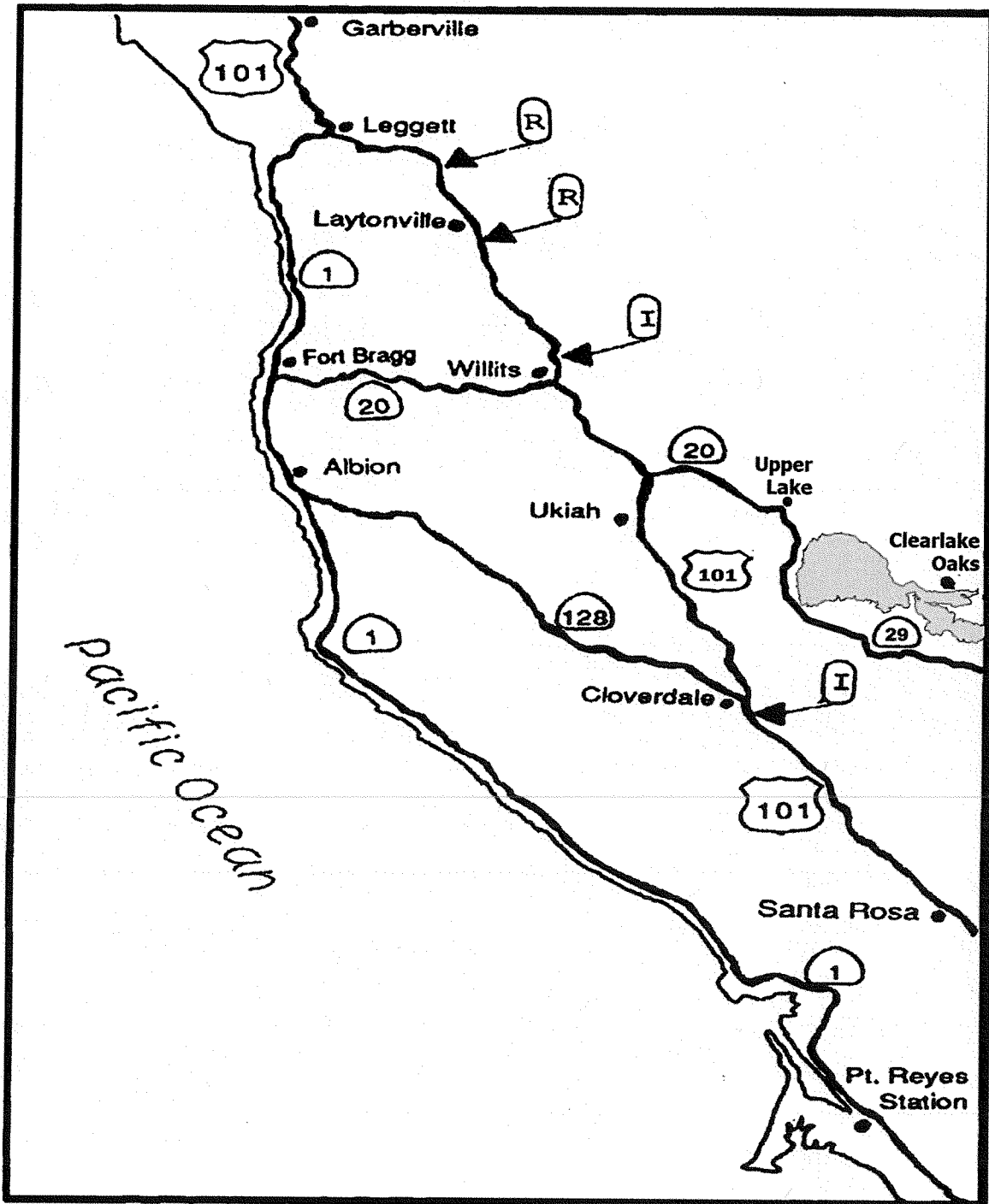
