TITLE 13, CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS DIVISION 2, CHAPTER 6.5 ARTICLE 7.5, SECTION 1239 IS AMENDED TO READ:

§1239. Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance North American Standard Out-of-Service Criteria.

- (a) *Applicability*. This article shall apply to those vehicles described in Section 34500 of the California Vehicle Code (CVC).
 - (1) Modified Limousines. Items specifically applicable to buses shall also be applicable to modified limousines.
- (b) *Incorporation by Reference*. This article incorporates by reference portions of the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance North American Standard Out-of-Service Criteria (rev. April 1, 20242025), including Part I, Part II, Part III, Part IV, and Appendix.
