Verification of the description and condition is the responsibility of the bidder. All sales are final.

<u>SMOG DEVICE</u>: Pursuant to California Vehicle Code 24007.5 notice is given that all buyers must obtain a certificate of compliance for smog control devices prior to registration. Purchase by dealers and vehicles sold for dismantling or for exclusive off-highway use are exempted from these requirements.
