### **"UNDER THE INFLUENCE"** Impairment Defined

- A person is *under the influence* if:
  - As a result of **drinking alcohol** and / or **taking a drug**
  - Mental or physical abilities so impaired...

Cannot drive vehicle with caution of sober person using ordinary care, under similar circumstances

## **PHYSICAL SYMPTOMS** *What We Expect...*





#### WHAT IS A "DRUG"? Vehicle Code §312

- Any substance or combination of substances (other than alcohol)
  Could so affect the nervous system, brain, or muscles
  As to impair, to an appreciable degree, ability to drive a vehicle in the way...
  Ordinarily prudent and cautious person
  - Full possession of faculties, using reasonable care
    - Would drive similar vehicle under like conditions

# **TYPES OF DUI OFFENSES**

**"GENERIC"**: Unlawful to drive a vehicle while **impaired** by alcohol and/or drug

<u>"PER SE"</u>: Unlawful to drive a vehicle with certain level of alcohol or drug in blood at time of driving Proof of impairment NOT required Determined by chemical test

## CALIFORNIA: VC § 23152 Basic DUI Statute

<u>GENERIC</u> - (a): UI Alcohol - (f): UI Drug - (g): Combo

n Alco + Drug

(c): Drug Addict
(d): .04% or ↑ *Commercial Veh.*(e): .04% or ↑ *Passenger VFH*Eff. 7/1/18

#### PER SE

(b): .08% or ↑

#### **"PRESUMPTIONS"** (Actually, Permissive Inferences)

#### LEVELS

**.08% or ↑:** "May, but are not required to conclude, Def. was DUI" (i.e., **impaired**) **.05% - <.08%:** No Presumption

**<.05%:** Presumed NOT UI, unless combo of drugs and alcohol

**NOTE:** These inferences affect proof of **impairment** ("Generic" alcohol DUI)

Some jurisdictions (not CA) *apply similar presumptions/ inferences to levels of certain drugs in blood* (e.g., THC) "Presumptive Levels"

## **IMPAIRED DRIVER** *Excuses That Don't Work (legally)*

- Subject Has a **Prescription / Medical Recommendation (MJ)** 
  - Not a defense!
- Subject was Tired, Fatigued, etc. Which Contributed to Impairment - Not a defense!

**Drug** Ingested was **OTC** or In Unusual Form *Not a defense!* 

# 11550 H&S vs. DUI Drugs

#### **11550 "UNDER THE INFLUENCE"**

*"Controlled substance has appreciably affected ... nervous system, brain, or muscles or has created...* **detectable abnormal** *mental or physical condition."* 

#### **DUI "UNDER THE INFLUENCE"**

"Mental or physical abilities are so impaired... no longer able to drive ... with the caution of a sober person...
