 Promote responsible sales and consumption practices to all cannabis retailers, dispensaries, home delivery services, through responsible retailer training similar to alcohol sales.

- Provide educational information the consumer can take such as pamphlets, posters and other information related to the responsible usage of cannabis and other drugs.
- 3. Provide age appropriate education for youth and adults on the effects of the use of cannabis and impact of impaired driving.
- 4. Expand education on the legal and judiciary side.
- 5. Provide medical system and pharmacy training related specifically to impaired driving.

The group then discussed the need to continue developing additional draft recommendations as the subcommittee continues to meet.
