## Correction Procedures

Once the written report has been completed and reviewed, it is important to prepare a plan outlining corrective measures to be implemented as a result of the assessment.

### Determine Areas of Focus

- Begin with the most potentially hazardous issues.

### Analyze the Alternatives

- Those provided in the report.
- Your own alternatives.

### Prepare Correction Outline

- Identify the necessary materials including equipment, hardware, and software.

## Implementation Phase

Select and implement the most effective recommendations contained in the correction procedure outline.

### Set Reasonable Time-frames

### Procure Needed Equipment, etc.

- Install equipment, etc.
- Test equipment, etc.

## Reassessment

Following a facility security survey, it is important to re-assess and evaluate the effectiveness of the corrections implemented.

### Walk Through Re-evaluation

#### Document

- Corrections made.
- Newly discovered hazards.
- Schedule next assessment.

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
