Call the CHP

- Report all crimes to the CHP.
- If you notice a suspicious person, remember the description. Call the CHP to investigate.
- If you feel the suspicious person could become violent, don't hesitate to call the CHP. In dealing with angry, frustrated people, stay as calm as possible and don't interrupt them.
- ➤ Keep a counter or desk between you and the other person. Maintain a distance of at least an arm's length.
- When you feel threatened, call another staff member or a supervisor to speak with the person or to stand by to give you support.
