FOREWORD

As a statewide law enforcement agency, the Department is called upon to respond to requests for law enforcement assistance within California or adjacent states. Requests for assistance vary from routine assistance to formal mutual aid. To adequately deal with these requests it is necessary for the Department to aid law enforcement agencies of political subdivisions, other states and the federal government.

The purpose of this manual is to provide policy, guidelines, and procedures for departmental personnel when responding to requests for law enforcement assistance, mutual aid, and interstate mutual assistance. Additionally, the manual discusses departmental jurisdiction on federal lands, response to claims of diplomatic or consular immunity, and interstate jurisdictional enforcement and investigation.

The objective of this manual is to promote uniformity of interpretation and application of laws and policies pertaining to departmental aid including temporary emergency assistance; supporting and upholding agencies during mutual aid operations and police labor controversies; interstate mutual assistance; interstate jurisdictional enforcement and investigation; departmental jurisdiction on federal lands; limited-term supplemental law enforcement assistance; and diplomatic or consular immunity.
