

CHAPTER 13

YOUTH BUS TERMINAL INSPECTION

1. GENERAL. This chapter addresses youth bus terminal inspection training procedures. This training category does not repeat Bus Terminal Inspection training (Chapter 9).

2. CLASSROOM TRAINING.

a. Prior to conducting "hands-on" youth bus terminal inspections, the MCSTO shall do the following:

(1) Direct the trainee to review the following references. Adequate time should be provided for completion of this segment of training.

(a) Authorities.

1 Authority to regulate the operation of youth buses (34500, and 34501(a)(1) VC).

2 Authority to inspect youth bus terminals (34501(c) VC).

3 Authority to inspect and certify youth buses annually (2807.3 VC).

(b) Policies and Procedures.

1 Policy (HPM 84.1, Chapter 1).

2 Inspection Procedures and Reports (HPM 84.1, Chapter 2).

3 Field Activity Reporting (HPM 84.1, Chapter 3).

4 School Pupil Activity Bus, Youth Bus, and General Public Paratransit Vehicle Inspection (HPM 84.1, Chapter 6).

(c) Vehicle Code.

3. FIELD HANDS-ON TRAINING.

- a. Field training shall be conducted in accordance with Chapter 7.
- b. Training shall include both initial and annual youth bus inspections and certifications.
