CHAPTER 20

INSPECTION AND MAINTENANCE STATION INSPECTION

1. GENERAL. This chapter addresses Inspection and Maintenance Station (IMS) terminal inspection training. This training category shall be preceded by instruction in one or more categories of carrier types authorized to obtain an IMS license.

2. CLASSROOM TRAINING.

a. Prior to conducting "hands-on" IMS terminal inspections, the MCSTO shall do the following:

(1) Direct the trainees to review the following applicable references. Adequate time should be provided for the completion of this segment of training.

(a) Authorities.

- 1 Authority to regulate IMS terminals (2525.2 VC).
- 2 Authority to make and enforce regulations (2525.8 VC).
- 3 Authority to license (2501 VC).
- 4 Authority to deny, suspend or revoke a license (2540 VC).
- 5 Authority to inspect (13 CCR 619.1).
